Our Treatment Options

We have a range of options for patients. We can supply patients with imported donor eggs for treatment in Ireland. Alternatively, we can facilitate treatment for patients who have sourced their own donor (e.g. a sister, cousin or friend). We can also provide treatment coordination services for patients who wish to travel abroad, providing linked care with Shady Grove Fertility in the USA, and Clínica Vistahermosa, Spain, for donor treatments abroad.



Donor Matching

To supply donor eggs for our import programme, we collaborate with an IVF clinic in Europe. The clinic recruits, screens and matches donors to your physical characteristics to match you with an identifiable donor who resembles you physically. Genetic matching can also be arranged on request.

Your Treatment Step by Step

Your treatment will take place in Ireland and the donor team at Waterstone Clinic is your point of contact throughout.



The Donor Match Process

Our partnered donor recruitment clinic in Europe recruits donors who are generally young, healthy women in their twenties who are likely to produce a significant number of eggs in a stimulated IVF cycle.

Donors undergo testing following strict international standards before they become available for matching, and viral screening is repeated at the time of egg collection. Optional genetic matching, which can screen for up to 300 genetic diseases, can also be arranged on request.

The below pathway details how donors are matched to recipients.



Our Imported Donor Egg Package

Your treatment is coordinated and delivered in Waterstone Clinic, with no requirement for you to travel abroad. Treatment with donor eggs is quite successful. In our experience, after blastocyst transfer, 50% of patients have a baby from treatment.

Treatment Coordination



- Consultation with fertility nurse specialist who has expertise in donor egg treatments
- Implications counselling session
- Assistance with the donor matching process
- Administrative support for statutory consent forms
- Communications at set stages during your care

Imported Donor Eggs



- 8 eggs from an identifiable donor matched to you
- Option to purchase additional oocytes

Laboratory Work



- Import acceptance and compliance checks
- Thaw and assessment of the donor eggs
- Specialised ICSI insemination procedure
- Incubation and monitoring of your embryos

- Management of your embryo transfer cycle
- Ultrasound scans
- Embryo transfer procedure
