

All patients are entitled to public HSE-funded treatment if they fit the below criteria. The HSE IVF Scheme is **not** related to the Medical Card Scheme. Patients **must be referred by their GP** to access the scheme. If patients do not fit the criteria, or have a preference, they can be referred (or self-refer) for self-funded treatment.

Eligibility Criteria:

- **Residency:** Both Partners must be residents of the Republic of Ireland
- **Age:** Both Partners must be over 18 years of age, and:
 - 40 or under for female partners
 - 59 or under for male partners
- **Relationship:** The couple must be in their relationship for more than 1 year with:
 - No more than **one** living child together
 - Either partner, but not both, may have **one** living child from a previous relationship
 - This includes children via adopted/born via surrogacy.
- **Medical:**
 - Female BMI must be between 18.5 - 30
 - No history of sterilisation (e.g. vasectomy or tubal ligation)
 - Previous Treatment does not exclude unless more than 1 IVF round or they have embryos in storage.
- **Lifestyle:**
 - Female partners must drink no more than 2 standard alcoholic drinks up to twice a week
 - Male partners must drink no more than 10 standard alcoholic drinks a week
 - Neither partner must have smoked or taken recreational drugs for at least 3 months

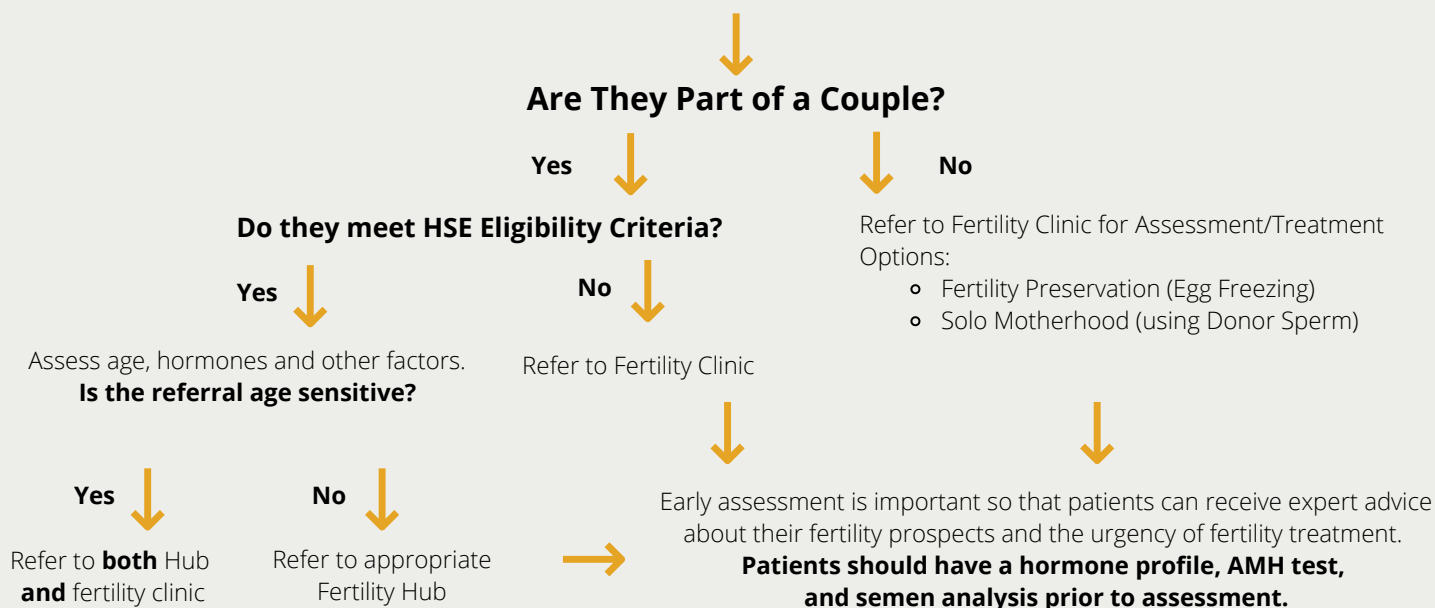
Ineligible Patients

- Female patients over 41
- Single women
- Same-sex couples
- Egg Donation patients
- Sperm Donation patients
- Secondary Infertility
- Over or underweight patients
- Patients with a history of sterilisation
- Patients with known genetic risk
